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Good Practice Guide for Plant Clinic Services in HEIs Definition and mapping of Network and Training Centers

The purpose of establishing the Plant Clinic network:

As the objective of this activity is to provide a guide showing the distinguished practices that are carried out in the plant clinic. Through this network, the beneficiaries can know that the activities offered by the plant clinic are well suited to what higher education institutions have in European universities. The network also facilitates not only the connection between all the participating universities from the Egyptian side, but also facilitates communication with the European side. The consolidated network shows the services provided to researchers as well as to members of the community interested in the agricultural sector and the protection of crops from pests in all plant clinic centers.

Establishment of the network:

The universities participating in the project have taken upon themselves the establishment of the network, and it is being developed and provided with the appropriate information. Information for the purpose of providing distinguished services in cooperation between the participating universities, and to ensure the sustainability of effective communication between partners for the purpose of review and development.

However, this communication on the network will not be satisfactorily effective until the students register for the diploma in the field of plant diseases.

The events in which the plant clinic was discussed and the importance of supporting it with all the necessary data:



- 1- Through the questionnaire that was implemented in the last period, the importance of exchanging information between the participating higher education institutions, and agricultural production sectors and graduates in the different regions of the Arab Republic of Egypt is shown. And that this communication must be implemented using the facilities provided by the networks.
- 2- The discussion that took place between the team participating in the project in Qena, Sohag, Suez Canal, Mansoura and Alexandria emphasized the importance of establishing a communications network. The network supports the unification of the ideas of all participants and creates easy and fast communication between academic workers and others wishing to work or benefit from the outputs of the plant clinic.
- 3- The homogeneity of the courses in the botanical clinic centers in all universities makes the presence of the network necessary to facilitate the procedures for developing the scientific content of the courses, teaching methods and assessment.
- 4- The visit of the project participants from Egypt to the European side.
- 5- The online training provided, clarified the importance of having a unified network between the participating Egyptian universities as well as with the European side.
