WP3. Training activities in plant clinic units for diploma program

Task 3.3 Training of academic staff from partner universities on ECTS and pedagogical education system by EU experts

The University of Naples Federico II (UNINA) is the leader of the WP.3 in which it is planned to carry out training activities in Plant Clinic for diploma program.

In order to apply ECTS system on the new DPCP program modules in teaching and evaluation, the task 3.3 includes the training of Academic staff from each Egypt partner university by EU experts on the following topics:

- The introduction of ECTS; the preparation of materials both for the learning of new credit system and the management of data required by academic staff, administrative staff and tutors.
- To know-how the overall ECTS and accumulation system; measuring and comparing learning achievements, recognition of periods of study abroad, enhancing the quality and volume of student mobility and;
- How transferring the system from one institution to another to be implemented at institutional, regional, national levels;

The Training programming is build around:

- The transfer of knowledge and good practice
- Learning from shared experience
- The acquiring of new practical skills
- To discovery of new ideas for teaching and learning

Following several meetings (11-05-21) and email exchanges between the partners, the following points were defined:

- The participation of the three European partners will be integrate in a single course, lasting a total of four days. The lessons will be recorded and will be available online.
- The course will be carried out online on Team platform to facilitate the participation of the partners.
- The traning will take place from november 29 to December 2. Two days of course will be held by experts from UNINA, the remaining two days of course will be held by experts from UNIDEB and AUP.
- There will be a final exam to test the level of learning and an Internal Survey to test.

Unina was responsible for distributing the course content among the European partners and defined the following detailed agenda, then sharing it among all the partners and participants.
