between

**Faculty of Agriculture, Suez Canal University and Cilia Company for Seeds Productions**

Today *Tuesday* dated 4/10/2022, this practical protocol is redacted between:

**First: Faculty of Agriculture, Suez Canal University**

legally represented by Dr./ Mohamed Ahmed Yassen as the Rector (first party)

**Second: Cilia Company**

Legally represented by Mr./ *Mohamed Sobhi* as Executive General Manager of the company (second party)

In the presence of Prof. Dr. Mohamed Yassen, the Dean of the Faculty of Agriculture

After acknowledging the authenticity of the data contained in each name and their contractual capacity, the parties agreed as follows:

**Preamble:**

Regarding the importance of the community partnership between the ecology and community service sector of the Faculty of Agriculture, Suez Canal University, and the private sector (**Cilia Company**) in transferring the knowledge represented by professors and lecturers of the Faculty and consultants of private sector companies represented by **Cilia Company** on both the product and the resource which benefits the community, the final consumer and therefore the Faculty of Agriculture in terms of exploiting the company's capabilities to train post-graduate students in the Faculty of Agriculture who joined to the **Diploma of Plant Clinic** and providing them with knowledge about the most modern practices on packing and exporting agricultural products, a partnership and cooperation protocol is developed between the Faculty of Agriculture, Suez Canal University and **Cilia Company**.

With the aim of sharing the benefit in kind and disseminating the culture and experience of qualified cadres in the field of plant production and protection provided by the Faculty members and training the students of plant clinic diploma, the company provides students with access to the latest practices for plant breeding and seed productions. Whereas the desire of the two parties to cooperate jointly in these areas converged, the two parties agreed on the following:

**Item 1**

The preamble above and all the pre-exchanged paper between the two parties are an integral part of this Agreement.

**Item 2**

**Areas of Cooperation:**

The two parties agreed to cooperate between each other in training post-graduate students who joined to the Diploma of Plant Clinic and creating job opportunities for the Faculty's graduate students who are specialized in the Company's area of competence

**Item 3**

**First party commitments**

- 1- The Faculty provides scientific and research expertise contributed by the Faculty members to participate with the Company's scientific consultants in seminars, workshops and public lectures inside and outside the university after tack acceptance measures
- 2- The faculty invites the company to participate in the Graduate Student Day Celebration held annually by it;
- 3- The Faculty provides appropriate scientific consultations by its members in the Company's area of work upon the request of the Company in accordance



with the rules specified by the Agricultural Consultancy and Services Center of the Faculty;

- ٤- The Faculty informs the Company of the students' names whose training is required at least ٣٠ days before the training starts; and
- ٥- The Faculty obliges a representative of the Agricultural Services and Plant Clinic Center to provide the necessary consultations and analyses of plant samples for the company as opposed to a ٢٥% discount from the cost of sample analysis or consultations in the field of plant clinic.

**Item ٤**

**Second party commitments**

Cilia Company provides the following:

- ١- Training opportunity for students of the Plant Clinic Diploma through training under the supervision of the Company's consultants; and

**Item ٥**

The duration of this Protocol is one year and starts at the date of its signature by the Parties and may be renewed for other same durations automatically unless one of the Parties notifies in a hand-delivered letter stating that it does not wish to renew the Protocol at least six months before its end.

**Item ٦**

This Agreement shall be redacted and signed by the Parties in two original copies and each party shall receive a copy to act under.
