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Graduation ceremony of first group of Diploma graduates

Student graduation ceremony plan

Students who pass all courses and the subject of the thesis will receive their diplomas on the day of the ceremony in May. The deans of the Faculty, the vice dean for postgraduate studies and research, the head of the botany and microbiology department, and a number of university professors and faculty members interested in plant diseases and health will be invited. A number of business men and some workers in the field of agricultural investment and agricultural companies are also invited.

At the ceremony, speeches will be given by senior farmers, workers in agricultural companies, and major investors in agricultural fields to explain to the attendees their requirements from Plant Clinic Center program and the job opportunities that their institutions can provide for graduates of the Plant Clinic Diploma. The program's faculty members (the program coordinator and the head of the Botany and Microbiology Department) also explain to the attendees in their speeches the strengthening of communication with members of the surrounding community working in the agricultural sector for the benefit of both parties, which includes developing the program's deliverables in a way that suits the requirements of the beneficiaries.

Arrangement for the ceremony:

1. Determine the date and location of the ceremony and notify the graduates during the final exams of the second semester.
2. Print the party invitations and distribute them after the thesis evaluation exam.
3. Organizing the ceremony location to suit the graduates' age stage.
4. Determine the total number of invitations and invitees.
5. Providing a photographer to take souvenir photos between students and attendees.
6. Distributing certificates of appreciation to three outstanding students.
7. Providing brochures to all attendees.
8. Providing a poster containing the project title and the funder (ERASMUS+).

Graduation ceremony agenda

1. The Holy Quran.
2. National Anthem.
3. A speech by the project coordinator at the university: in which the present students and guests are welcomed and introduced to the program of the daily ceremony and how it will proceed. The diploma and center of the plant clinic and the role of the European Union are also introduced.
4. Show a short video about the stages of student training.
5. A speech by a representative of the graduates.
6. Speech by the Head of the Department of Science and Microbiology.
7. Speech and representative of the college for postgraduate studies and research affairs
8. Message from the Dean of the College.
9. A word to investors in the agricultural sector.
10. A word about companies working in the field of pesticides and fertilizers.

Planning the party

1. Choosing an appropriate name for the first graduation ceremony for plant clinic diploma students.
2. Providing an adequate financial budget.
3. Preparing hospitality supplies for attendees, students and their families.
4. Choose a suitable décor for the ceremony venue that matches the graduates' theme.

Graduation party outfit

Providing graduation uniforms or academic dress. Graduation uniforms are traditional academic clothing that is often worn when graduating and obtaining various university degrees. Today this dress generally consists of an abaya, and a hat that is often square in shape. Academic dress is also worn formally by some members of the scientific community.

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
